Gosaikunda Helicopter Tour Package - Itinerary

Day 1: Arrive in Kathmandu, Nepal

1. Meet with your tour operator and discuss the tour itinerary
2. Rest and acclimatize to the altitude

Day 2: Early morning helicopter flight to Gosaikunda Lake

1. Early morning helicopter flight to Gosaikunda Lake
2. Enjoy the stunning views of the Himalayas from the helicopter
3. Land at Gosaikunda Lake and explore the area
4. Visit the sacred Gosaikunda temple and take a dip in the holy waters of the lake
5. Return back to Kathmandu from helicopter

Day 3: Full day sight seeing in Kathmandu

Following the morning breakfast there will be a vehicle to pick you up for the full-day sightseeing which will be:

1. Pashupatinath
2. Baudhanath
3. Patan or Kathmandu City Darbar Square
4. Swayambhunath

Day 4: Departure from Kathmandu

Departure will be done 3 hrs before flight timing.

1. Can kids join us on this helicopter tour?

You can bring your kids on this flight without any problems, so please do. It is perfect for both children and adults because we give you a luxurious and enjoyable helicopter tour.

2. Does the helicopter have a supply of oxygen cylinders?

In the event of an emergency, oxygen cylinders will be provided. You won't typically require much oxygen, though, as this is a straightforward excursion to see Gosaikunda and other high Himalayan mountains.

3. In Nepal, is the Gosaikunda Helicopter Tour secure?

Yes, as long as you go by the safety advice provided by our knowledgeable tour guides, the Gosaikunda Helicopter Tour in Nepal is entirely safe.

4. What is the duration of the Gosaikunda Helicopter Tour?

From the airport to the destination, the trip will take 1 and a half hours. On the other hand, where you depart from affects how long it takes to go to the airport. You can fly out of either Pokhara Airport in Pokhara or Tribhuvan International Airport in Kathmandu.

5. How far do we travel during the journey?

The maximum altitude reached during this brief Heli ride will be at Gosaikunda Lake, at 4,380 meters. For this specific journey, the helicopter ascends about 4,500 meters.
